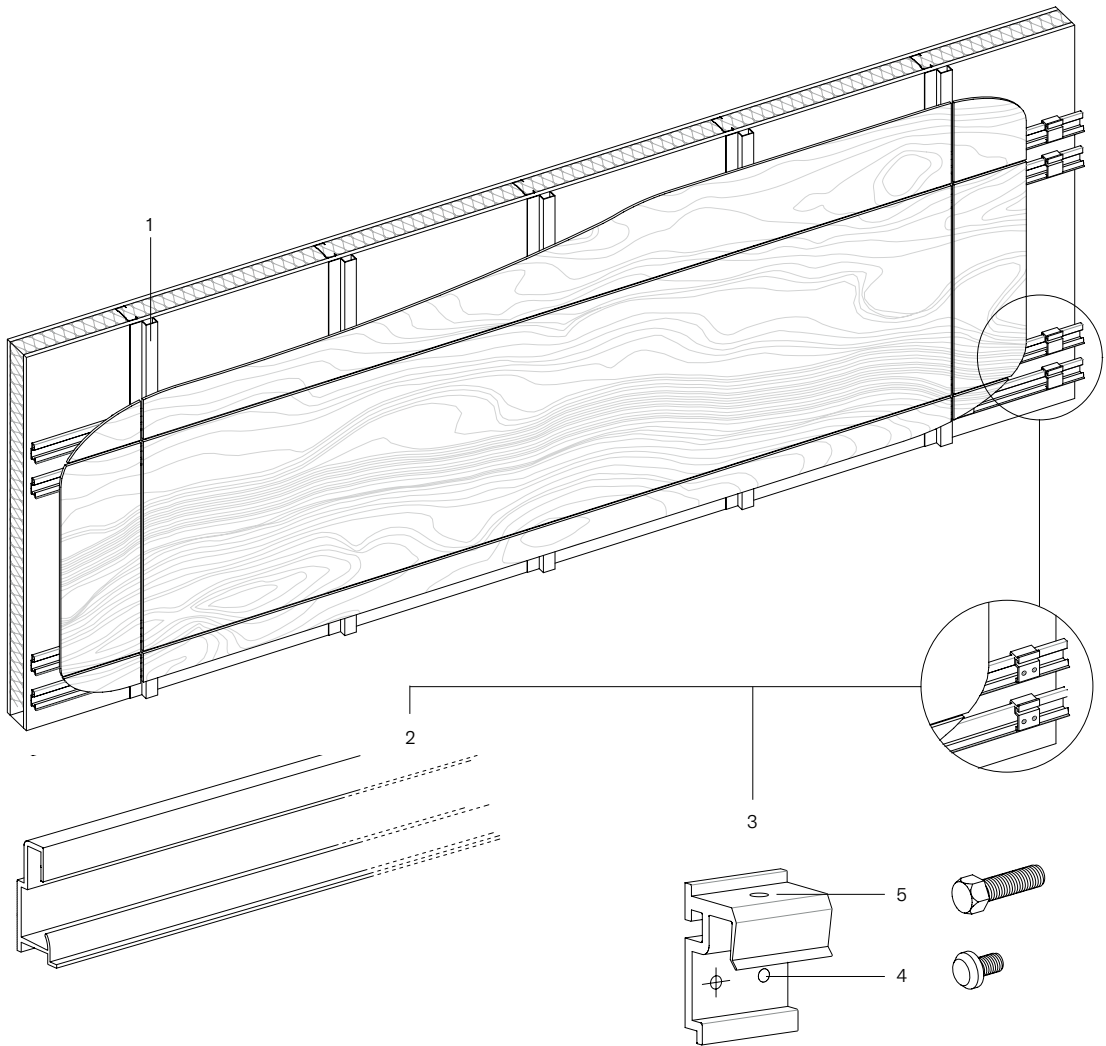
To fit each project's needs, we offer a tailored installation of our cladding panels. The standard board of 96"×48"/2440×1220 mm can be custom-cut according to the facade sectioning defined by the design - we can also provide 106"×48"/2700×1220 mm panels upon request. Panel thicknesses range from 8 to 22mm in 2mm increments, being 8 and 10mm the most used. Panels with a thickness of 6mm are available for special applications. The substructure shown in the images is an example of a substructure valid for ventilated facades.
